## Boost to Terramin Team

**Terramin Australia Limited (ASX:TZN) is pleased to report two significant additions to its team. Mr Ian Holman and Mr Sam Hewitt are both mining engineers with substantial experience in block caving operations that will be invaluable for the Algerian operation and existing mining projects.**

Mr Ian Holman's career covering most aspects of mining, commencing in a Zambian block cave operation, then in operations in South Africa, Botswana and Ghana. He spent nine years in Australia in various roles, including Project Manager and Chief Mining Engineer for Pasminco/Zinifex. He then managed the design and construction of the 8 Mtpa Argyle Diamonds block cave operation in Western Australia, where he led the evaluation of mechanical mining methods including the assessment of road headers such as those under consideration to speed up the development of the Tala Hamza mine. Most recently Mr Holman was Director and General Manager Planning and Resources for RioTinto Minerals in Toulouse, France.

Mr Holman will be Terramin's Chief Mining Engineer and Adviser to the Managing Director. He will oversee many aspects of the Company's projects and mining operations.

Mr Hewitt, currently at BHP's Olympic Dam operation, has 15 years experience in mining and tunneling. He worked for eight years with Freeport-McMoran, primarily at the giant Grasberg block caving and stoping operation in Indonesia. His latest role was General Superintendent for the 29Mtpa Deep MLZ block cave project. His responsibilities included training and development of the local Indonesian workforce to enhance safety, quality and efficiency. His experience will benefit the proposed Tala Hamza mine, which includes twin decline access and close spaced drawpoint development.

Mr Hewitt will be Principal Mining Engineer for the Company's projects, assisting the mining team at Angas, scoping for mining of the Central Zone deposit at Menninnie, and in Algeria.

Terramin's Executive Chairman, Dr Kevin Moriarty, said that the appointments were important to augment the experienced finance, geology and project management professionals already in the Company's team. "Following the recent appointment of Mr Nic Clift, the key capability now exists to effect the Tala Hamza development."
