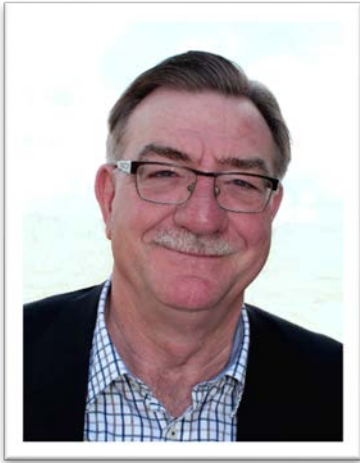


MR KELVIN TRIMPER BSc, Grad. Dip T (Sec), FUDIA, FUniSA



Kelvin Trimper is the Principal of Kelvin Trimper Consulting, a business formed when he left Lend Lease in April, 2012. The business is primarily involved in Strategic Planning, Project Collaboration and Economic, Community and Education Development. Kelvin has worked nationally with State and Local Governments, Business Leaders, Education and Community Service Providers in delivering large scale, Master Planned Developments.

Kelvin played a key role as Project Director in the winning and establishment of the mixed-use Mawson Lakes (formerly MFP) project in Adelaide and was involved with Mawson Lakes throughout its entire development. He now works with Local Government, State Government and the Private Sector to foster collaboration on and the delivery of challenging projects.

Kelvin is a Fellow of the University of South Australia, past President and a Fellow of the Urban Development Institute of Australia (South Australia Division). He was also the Chair of the Advisory Board for UniSA's Zero Waste SA Research Centre for Sustainable Design and Behaviour and UniSA's Centre for Work and Life Advisory Board until 2014.

Kelvin chairs the Northern Economic Leaders Group which comprises business leaders in Northern Adelaide and also chairs Northern Futures, a not-for-profit organisation focussed on assisting disadvantaged and unemployed citizens back into training or employment. He is also one of the business representatives involved in developing the Northern Economic Plan in partnership with State and Local Governments.

In 2012 Kelvin was named the City of Salisbury's Citizen of the Year.

In 2015 Kelvin was appointed President of The World Federation of Rose Societies.
