POTENTIAL SUPPLIER

The mining approval system is a lengthy process which means requirements associated with construction and operation of the Bird in Hand Gold Project will not start immediately. As a result Terramin has plenty of time to plan for the supply of required goods and services. Terramin will work with local business to help them prepare for any supply.

Terramin will have potential supplier packs which will contain the required information that will be required to set up an account. This will include levels of insurance, payment terms and ordering systems.

In relation to supplies, all products will have to be;

- approved for use in Australia,
- will require a hazard assessment and
- include a safe method of operation and
- if appropriate a Material Safety Data Sheet.

If required Terramin will work with suppliers to produce the required documentation.

Preferred Supplier Policy

Terramin has a preferred supplier or service provider policy which includes a number of criteria driving its tender process.

Suppliers located within the Woodside area, the Adelaide Hills and the State of South Australia will be considered in priority subject to compliance with Terramin's requirements including (without limitation) quality, safety, expertise and price.

Health and Safety

Any company providing services or delivering goods on site must comply with health and safety laws and obligations relevant to mine sites. Typically this is undertaken by having company policies, procedures and training systems within a safety management system (SMS). Where local companies comply with supply capability and have completed the supply agreements Terramin is willing to assist suppliers in developing an appropriate SMS to ensure communication of hazards and safety of all workers.

It is a standard Terramin Australia requirement for Suppliers and Contractors to hold the following minimum insurance:

- \$20 million Public & Product Liability Cover;
- Insurance covering supplier or service provider's property;
- Motor vehicle insurance; and
- (if relevant) professional indemnity
