Government Controls

The granting of a Mining Lease by the Minister follows a defined process (as shown on right). A Mining Lease application is developed which includes consultation with stakeholders.

The Minister reviews the project elements during the assessment to ensure:

- there is a reasonable prospect that a mineral resource can be 'effectively and efficiently mined'.
- all potential environmental impacts have been identified.
- the proposed level of impact (environmental outcome) is acceptable given the economic and social benefits.
- the proposed control strategies will achieve an acceptable level of impact.
- there is a control mechanism at all stages during the development of the Bird in Hand Gold Project, Terramin work to ensure regulatory requirements and expectations are met.

In addition to this, Terramin is required to complete an application to the Minister for Sustainability, Environment and Conservation under S128 of the Natural Resources Management Act 2004, for an authorisation to take and use water. Terramin also intends to reinject water and will include this request in documentation to the Department for Environment and Water (DEW).
